We are currently looking for a **Book Reviews Editor** and would like to hear from enthusiastic individuals with a vision for promoting scholarship and fostering debate in the field of educational technology.

Each year JIME publishes reviews of some of the latest books released on the topics of educational technology and the role of multimedia technologies in higher education. Titles available for review are listed on the journal site each year and expressions of interest invited, including a brief biographical statement. Reviews are commissioned on a first-come, first served basis for qualified reviewers. Reviews are published together by the end of the year.

The role of the **Book Reviews Editor** includes:

- Identifying and requesting relevant books from publishers for review
- Commissioning and communicating with book reviewers
- Editing book reviews to a publishable standard
- Participating in meetings of JIME's editorial team (monthly)
- Familiarity with the journal publishing system – training will be given

Applicants are welcome who have a PhD qualification in the field of educational technology; enthusiasm and sufficient (realistic) capacity to fulfil the time commitment required of the role (1-2 hours per week).
